## OFSTED

Following the recent visit of OFSTED inspectors on Monday and Tuesday of this week, I am extremely pleased with the feedback we have been given. Thank you for taking the time to write so many positive comments about our school and to engage in discussions with the inspectors as they moved around from class to class. The inspectors were very impressed, particularly with the way in which children behaved and how they were able to talk about important issues such as how to keep safe and how best to learn. I am delighted at the children's response. The inspectors looked at all aspects of the school and will produce a report which will be sent to us very soon. The report will then be sent out so that you can read in more detail about the judgements made.

### Year 6 Travel Awareness Training

Yesterday Year 6 had a visit from Martin from Travel Awareness South Yorkshire. They came into school to explain to us the rules of travelling on buses. Martin talked about behaviour on buses and what to do if you had a problem on the bus. He also spoke about other people travelling on buses and what to do if gangs of children surrounded you. He told us the safest thing to do if you have any problems is to go to the lower deck because you can then inform the bus driver.

At the end we did a quiz and if you got 10 out of 10 Martin is bringing us a prize into school. If you got 9 out of 10 you received a ruler and everyone was given a pencil for attending the training. Next week Year 6 will be attending Crucial Crew where they will be continuing this training and learning about other methods of transport.
